Precautionary Statements

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Inhalation: Move to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is

difficult, give oxygen. Get medical attention.

Skin contact: Immediately flush skin with plenty of water (using soap, if available). Remove

contaminated clothing and footwear. Get medical attention. Wash clothing

before reuse. Thoroughly clean shoes before reuse.

Eye contact: Rinse immediately with plenty of water, also under the eyelids, for at least 15

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5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Extinguishing media: Water spray (fog), foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Environmental precautions: Do not allow product to enter sewer or waterways.

Clean-up methods: Remove all sources of ignition. Evacuate and ventilate spill area; dike spill to

prevent entry into water system; wear full protective equipment during cleanup. Refer to Section 8 "Exposure Controls / Personal Protection" prior to clean up. Soak up with inert absorbent material (e.g. sand, silica gel, acid binder, universal binder, sawdust). Scrape up as much material as possible. Store in a

partly filled, closed container until disposal.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling: Use only with adequate ventilation. Prevent contact with eyes, skin and

clothing. Do not breathe vapor and mist. Wash thoroughly after handling.

Storage: For safe storage, store at or below 32 °C (89.6 °F)

Keep container tightly closed and in a cool, well-ventilated place away from incompatible materials. Store away from heat, sparks, flames, or other

sources of ignition. Protect from direct sunlight.
